

Dividend of SEK 1.125 billion to Lantmännen's members

Lantmännen's strong results for 2024 enable a dividend of SEK 1.125 billion to members – the second highest dividend ever. The decision was made at Lantmännen's Annual General Meeting today.

The billion-kronor dividend is a significant contribution to profitable and competitive Swedish agriculture, while also contributing to a robust food supply. In 2024, Lantmännen delivered an operating profit adjusted for items affecting comparability of SEK 2,868 million. This is a new record result for Lantmännen, Food division, the Swecon business area and the Real Estate business area improved their results during the year.

"Lantmännen has a strong business portfolio and robust strategy, and we continue to invest to create profitable growth in our business and to strengthen Swedish agriculture and Swedish food production.
